COMPETITION RULES: Current World Taekwondo Rules will govern these championships.

METHODS OF COMPETITION: Single elimination tournament system.

KYORUGI COMPETITION:

-Each World Taekwondo Pan America Member National Association (MNA) may enter No more than ONE (1) competitor per weight division. The maximum number of competitors per MNA is twenty (20). No athlete is allowed to participate in more than one (1) weight or age category.

-Ten (10) Official Weight Categories per Male & Female. Twenty (20) competitors maximum per MNA.

-Wild Card Invitation holders from 2018 WT Pan Am President's Cup must register through the Wild Card Holder's Member National Association (MNA) with no exceptions.

OFFICIAL UNIFORMS: All Sparring athletes must wear WT approved black V-neck white uniform (dobok) in good condition. Patches, embroidery, logos, team names, country names, athlete names, and stripes are permitted on uniforms. NO TAPING IS ALLOWED ON ANY PART OF THE UNIFORM. Please refer to latest WT Rules & Regulations.

COACHES ATTIRE: All coaches must oblige to wearing business suits (tie optional) for the semifinals and final rounds. Coaches that do not follow the dress code will not be allowed to enter the field of play during finals and semifinals. No phone and hearing devices on coaching seat. Closed toe shoes are mandatory.

KYORUGI EQUIPMENT: DAEDO Generation 2 PSS & E head system. Each athlete must provide own Gen 2 Daedo sensor socks.
