**FOR USA ONLY:** USA competitors and coaches must hold current USA Taekwondo membership prior to Global License approval. USA Participants must allow up to 14 business days for your Global Licenses to be approved and processed. ## GENERAL PROVISIONS:

This is a World Taekwondo **G-2 Kyorugi & G-2 Poomsae** ranked tournament, offering **WILD CARDS** to **Senior winners for the 2020 Pan Am Senior Kyorugi & Poomsae Championships.**

## COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY AND FEES:

All participants must satisfy the following requirements in order to participate. This is an "Open" event, open to all current Global Athletes License (GAL) holders.

- All competitors must hold passport or birth certificate of the country they will represent.

- Competitors will compete at the age based on their birth year.

**Early Registration Fee** (ends September 15, 2019 11:59 PM GMT-10):

- USD\$150.00 for first event. Extra \$100 for each additional event.

**Regular Registration Fee** (ends September 30, 2019 11:59 PM GMT-10):

- USD\$175.00 for first event. Extra \$125 for each additional event.

**Late Registration Fee** (ends October 4, 2019 11:59 PM GMT-10):

- USD\$250.00 for first event. Extra \$150 for each additional event.

## COACH ELIGIBILITY AND FEES:

- All Coaches must be at least 18 years of age, current GOL **and** World Taekwondo Coach Permit holders (granted by participating in a Continental Union Coach Seminar).

- **Coaches who fail to provide proof of current 2019 WT Coach Permit will be subjected to an additional USD\$200 penalty in order to coach at this event.**

- Kyorugi or Poomsae: Early & Regular registration fee of USD\$150 by September 30, 2019; Late registration fee of USD\$250 by October 4, 2019, 11:59 PM U.S. Mountain Time.

- Kyorugi AND Poomsae Coaches pay USD\$300 by September 30, 2019; USD\$500 from October 1 - 4, 2019, 11:59 PM GMT-10.

## MNA DELEGATE, TEAM DOCTOR, TRAINER ELIGIBILITY:

- Must be current holders of World Taekwondo Global Officials License (GOL) in 2019.

- USD\$150 registration fee for the entire duration of the event.

- WT GMS Registration by October 4, 2019 ONLY. No registration will be accepted at the Accreditation Desk onsite.

- MNA Presidents: NO PAYMENT REQUIRED but must register via [WT Simply Compete](#) and select "**MNA PRESIDENT**" Role. Registration is non-transferrable and subject to OC verification.

- Athletes and coaches must pay IN FULL by the early, regular or final registration deadline to receive the registration fee at that rate. If an Athlete register during the Early Registration period but do not pay by the Early Registration deadline, the individual will have to pay the fee that is applicable for the registration period when payment is made.
- When an Athlete register and pay for the first event during the Early/Regular Registration period, then add a new event during the Regular or Late registration period, the individual will be charged the fee difference between two registration periods for the first event AND pay respective fees for the registration period of which the new event was added. ### DRAW OF LOTS:

All competitors will be seeded according to WT World Ranking as per October 10, 2019. All G-2 Senior Kyorugi will use single elimination with 100% seeding. All other Kyorugi divisions will use single elimination with a randomized computer draw. All G-2 Poomsae (Individual Under 30 & Under 40 divisions) will use single elimination with a randomized computer draw. All other Poomsae divisions will use cut-off system with a randomized computer draw. The draw sheets and brackets will be available in the PATU Facebook Page by 11:55 PM PST the night before the competition of the respective Kyorugi and Poomsae divisions. All competitors that failed to show up or failed to make weight will be removed from the bracket.

### WILD CARD QUALIFICATION:

The top four medalist of each **Senior Kyorugi** and **Senior Poomsae** divisions will be eligible to receive Wild Card Invitations to the **2020 Pan Am Senior Championships**.

*\* No Cadet & Junior Wild Cards will be offered at this event. \**

### WILD CARD PARTICIPANT ELIGIBILITY:

- Kyorugi Wild Cards, Senior Divisions: Competitors must be born in or before 2002. Competitors who were born in 2002 may compete in the Senior Kyorugi Divisions at the 2019 World Taekwondo President's Cup.
- Recognized Poomsae Wild Cards: Individual Poomsae (Under 30, Under 40, Under 50, Under 60, Under 65 & Over 65), Pairs and Team (Under 30 & Over 30)
- Freestyle Poomsae Wild Cards: Individual (Over 17), Pair and Mixed Team (Over 17)

### Wild Card Selection Guidelines:

1. The Wild Card invitation is available for ONE competitor per country in each Senior Kyorugi division (Male and Female) and each Senior Poomsae division (Recognized Poomsae: Individual, Pair, Team and Freestyle Poomsae: Individual, Pair, Team).
2. In the event that more than one competitor wins from the same country, ONLY the highest ranked medalist from that country will receive the Wild Card, while the lower ranked medalist from the same country will NOT be entitled to a Wild Card in that division.
3. In the event that the two Bronze Medalist are from the same country, ONLY the competitor that lost to the Gold Medalist will receive the Wild Card and the other Bronze Medalist from the same country will NOT be entitled to a Wild Card in that division.
4. Poomsae will follow the same guidelines as stated above.
5. In the event that there is a tie between the two Bronze Medalist and they are both from the same country in a Cut-Off Poomsae division, WT Poomsae Tie Break Rules will be followed and ONLY the higher ranked medalist will be awarded the Wild Card, while the other lower ranked medalist winner from the same country will NOT be entitled to a Wild Card in that division.

**Explanation:** For example, Canada wins Gold, Canada wins Silver, and Mexico & Mexico wins both Bronze. ONLY the Gold Medalist from Canada will win the Canada Wild Card and ONLY the Bronze Medalist from Mexico that lost to the Gold Medalist will win the

## Kyorugi Rules and Competition Format

Organizing committee has the right to change, modify the duration of rounds, divisions and make official decisions without prior notices.

### HEAD OF THE TEAM / TECHNICAL MEETING:

PATU technical officials shall conduct the Head of Team meeting on Thursday, October 10, 2019 at 7:00 PM. Head of the team meeting will be held at Westgate Hotel Las Vegas.

The WT Technical Delegate and Organizing Committee have the rights to change, modify the duration of rounds, and combine divisions at the Head of Team meeting. The official drawing will be done by the computer automatically and posted on to the PATU Facebook Page "[World Taekwondo Pan America – PATU](#)".

### OFFICIAL UNIFORM:

All Kyorugi competitors must wear WT approved white uniform (dobok) with black V-neck in good condition. Patches, embroidery, logos, team names, country names, competitor names, and stripes are permitted on uniforms. NO TAPING IS ALLOWED ON ANY PART OF THE UNIFORM.

### COACHES ATTIRE:

All coaches must oblige to wearing business suits (tie optional) for the semifinals and final rounds. Coaches that do not follow the dress code will not be allowed to enter the field of play during finals and semifinals. No hearing devices/phones at coach seats.

### KYORUGI EQUIPMENT:

Organizer will be using DAEDO Generation 2 PSS system for all Kyorugi divisions.

All Youth, Cadet, Junior, Senior, Ultra divisions will be using DAEDO Gen 2 Body & Headgear provided by the OC. All competitors are **REQUIRED** to purchase and use their own Daedo socks for the Kyorugi competition. Daedo socks can be purchased by visiting the Daedo sales booth at the event.

## HEAD OF THE TEAM / TECHNICAL MEETING:

PATU officials shall conduct the Head of the Team meeting on Thursday, October 10, 2019 at 7:00 PM. Head of the Team meeting will be held at Westgate Hotel, Las Vegas.

Designated Poomsae will be drawn at the Head of Team Meeting Thursday, October 10, 2019 at 7:00 PM. Designated Poomsae will be posted on WT Pan America Facebook page "[World Taekwondo Pan America – PATU](#)" at 11:55 pm on October 10<sup>th</sup>.

## OFFICIAL UNIFORM:

All Poomsae competitors must wear the proper WT approved uniform (dobok) with the proper Y-neck in good condition. Poom Belts MUST be worn for competitors in Poom collared Y-neck Poomsae uniforms.

## COACHES ATTIRE:

## POOMSAE COMPETITION RULES & RANKING:

Current WT Poomsae Competition Rules and WT Poomsae Ranking bylaws will govern the 2019 WT President's Cup.

### RECOGNIZED CATEGORY (Individual, Pair, Team):

Minimum: None; Maximum: 90-seconds; Rest: 30-seconds

### FREESTYLE CATEGORY (Individual, Pair, Mixed Team):

Minimum 90-seconds; Maximum: 100-seconds

## G-RANKED POOMSAE:

Single Elimination for All G-Ranked Recognized Individual Poomsae divisions (Individual Under 30 & Under 40) with a 100% seeded draw. All competitors who fail to report will be disqualified.

## NON-G-RANKED POOMSAE:

Cut-Off system will be used for All Non-G-Ranked Poomsae divisions with a random computer draw. All competitors who fail to report will be disqualified.

## SINGLE ELIMINATION SYSTEM:

The latest WT Poomsae single elimination rules will be in effect. Competitors shall perform two (2) designated compulsory Poomsae per round.

## CUT-OFF SYSTEM:

**Preliminaries:** When 20 or more competitors are participating; competition shall start from the Preliminary Round with division of groups at different rings. Competitors shall perform one (1) designated compulsory Poomsae, and half of each group's competitors shall advance to the Semi-Final Round based on the highest scores. In the Preliminary Round, each group may be judged by a different group of judges. If the number of competitors is odd, the number of competitors will be rounded to an even number. Ex.: If there are 23 competitors in the division, it will be considered as 24 competitors and 12 shall advance to the Semi-Final Round.

**Semi-Final Selection:** When 9 to 19 competitors are participating; competition shall start from the Semi-Final Round. Competitors shall perform one (1) designated compulsory Poomsae, and 8 competitors shall advance to the Final Round based on the highest scores.

**Final:** When 8 or fewer competitors are participating, competition shall start from the Final Round. Competitors shall perform two (2) designated compulsory Poomsae, and the top four individual competitors/pair/team shall be awarded medals based on their rank in the Final Round. In the case of a tie, WT Poomsae Tie Breaking Rules apply. Both 3rd and 4th place is awarded with bronze medals.

### OFFICIAL UNIFORMS:

All Demo Team competitors must wear WT approved white uniform (dobok) with black V-neck in good condition. Patches, embroidery, logos, team names, country names, competitor names, and stripes are permitted on uniforms. NO TAPING IS ALLOWED ON ANY PART OF THE UNIFORM. NO KNEE OR ELBOW PADS. **Y-neck Poomsae uniforms are not permitted.**

### DEMONSTRATION TEAM COMPETITION:

- Maximum time to complete the demonstration is 10 minutes including set-up and clean-up time.
- The routine shall be done within the 12 m x 12 m area.
- Minimum of 7 members and no more than 10 members. All Demo Teams must be self-sufficient for the Board Breaking part of their Demo routine. No coach, master or outside board holders are allowed. Boards must be held by demo team members.
- No pyrotechnics, fireworks or rockets.
- Boards, weapons, official tables or other accessories shall be provided by the demonstration team.
- All Demo performances must include: Recognized Poomsae (All Members), Freestyle Team Poomsae (Max 5 Members), Self-Defense, and a Board Breaking Routine. Additional routines are encouraged.
- Higher presentation points will be awarded for using weapons during the demo.
- Music MUST be submitted to Accreditation on a clearly marked USB Drive with Team Name by 4 PM on October 10, 2019. USB Drive submitted will be available for pick up at Accreditation between October 11–13, 2019. **Song Lyrics are NOT permitted.**
- Teams without music will be disqualified.

### DEMO TEAM SCORING:

Based on the following order of superiority in ascending order:

1. Synchronization Technique (20%).
2. Excitement on the performance (20%).
3. Successful completion of Taekwondo Techniques (20%).
4. Entertainment Generated (20%).
5. Display of Precision, Speed, and Power (20%).

### Major Deduction (0.5 points):

- Any part of the body above the ankle bone that touch the mats.
- Crossing the boundary line with both feet.
- Under or Over time
- Inability to complete all four (4) mandatory skills.
- Assistance from team members in completing aerial techniques.
- Assistance from board holders by hitting boards to breakers' feet.
- Extreme remarkable and offensive behavior amongst coaches and competitors; failure to obey directions from referees / officials.

### Minor Deduction (0.1 points):

- Failure to break boards or execute board breaking techniques.
- Losing balance, extended pause, lack of synchronization and harmony.
