7.2 Holder of the Kukkiwon 1st Poom or Dan certificate (KYORUGI)

7.3 Holder of WT Global Athlete License (GAL).

7.4 Contestants at the age of at least 17 years old for Senior in the year the pertinent tournament is held 15-17 years old for Junior Division.

The age limit is based on the year, not on the date. For instance, if the Junior Championships are held on November, 7th, 2019, those contestants born on between January 1, 2002 and December 31, 2004 are eligible to participate.

8. COMPETITION RULES:

Kyorugi: 2019 WT Competition Rules.

Poomsae: Current WT Poomsae Competition Rules will govern the event. In Recognized Poomsae competition, age divisions under 40, under 50, under 65, over 65 shall be integrated into the over 40 division.

9. METHOD OF COMPETITION

Kyorugi:

Single Elimination system

Poomsae:

Recognized Poomsae: all competitions shall be conducted in Single Elimination Tournament.

Free-style Poomsae: Cut-off System, however, if less than 16 teams participating, there shall be final round only.

10. DURATION OF CONTEST

10.1 Recognized Poomsae: Individual, Pair, and Mixed Team competitions from 30 seconds to 90 seconds.

10.2 Free Style Poomsae: Individual, Pair, and Mixed Team competitions from 60 seconds to 70 seconds.

10.3 Break time between 1st poomsae and 2nd poomsae is 30 to 60 seconds.

10.4 2 minutes x 3 rounds with 1 minute break (Kyorugi)

13. KYORUGI WEIGH-IN

Weigh-in of the contestants shall take place on the day before their respective weight category.

During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. However, contestants may weigh-in in the nude if they wish to do so.

14. ENTRY FEES

14.1 Entry registration: Entry will only be accepted through the WT GMS Online Registration System: <https://worldtkd.simplycompete.com/events>. The registration will be closed on Nov. 5th, 2019, 11:59PM.

14.2 Registration period starts on Nov. 4th and ends on Nov. 5th, 2019

14.3 Entry fee:

Kyorugi:

- US\$ 100 per athlete

Poomsae:

- US\$ 30 per competition event

14.4 Entry fee: all payments for each contestant should be paid in cash (US dollars) to OC at the Accreditation Center at host hotel before checking-in the hotel. Athletes will not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee.

16. WT-RECOGNIZED TAEKWONDO UNIFORM (DOBOK) AND PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (KYORUGI)

14.1 Daedo Protector and Scoring System (PSS) including PSS Headgear will be used for the competition.

14.2 Participating contestants are required to wear WT-recognized doboks and WT-recognized protective equipment. The latest version of WT-recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of WT (<http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtf-partners/recognized/>)

14.3 The Organizing Committee will provide Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.

14.4 Instant Video Replay (IVR) System will be used.

18. ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORTATION

GMS registration system – worldtkd.simplycompete.com by no later than October 20th, 2019. The hotel information is available on the WT GMS platform.

Ground transportation will be provided for national teams on arrival and departure free of charge only for teams who book via the WT GMS booking platform and include the date, time, airline & flight number of the national team's arrival and departure at the latest by the designated deadline (October 20th, 2019).

19. INTERNATIONAL REFEREES:

19.1 LOC will appoint the required number of WT Kyorugi and Poomsae International Referees.

20. TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND COMPETITION SUPERVISORY BOARD

The WT will appoint the Technical Delegate and the members of the Competition Supervisory Board who shall oversee the competition.

21. MEDICAL CONTROL:

21.1 The WT Anti-Doping Rules and the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions.

22. INDEMNITIES

Each athlete shall be responsible for ensuring that he or she is covered with effective travel & medical insurance coverage.

Any athlete without proper insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the competition.

The Organizing Committee will acquire general Public Liability event insurance.

23. HEAD OF TEAM MEETING AND DRAWING OF LOTS:

The Head of Team Meeting and the Drawing of Lots session shall be conducted one (1) day prior to the start of the championships that is November 6th, 2019, in the

presence of the Technical Delegate, WT officials and the representatives of the participating nations.

24. VISA INFORMATION

The Organizing Committee can provide recommendation letters for visa applications. However, MNA's are required to check the China entry visa application waiting times in their own countries and submit requests for recommendation letters to the organizing committee.

The Organizing Committee cannot guarantee entry into China and can only offer assistance. It is the responsibility of each athlete and MNA to apply for and secure the correct entry visa for China. MNA's are requested to complete the attached visa application recommendation form at least one week before the waiting time deadline in their own country.

25. COACH'S ATTIRE

All Coaches are required to wear formal suit such as tie, jacket, dress shirt (long or short), and trouser during all competitions. If any coach refuses to wear abovementioned attire, he or she will not be allowed to coaching for the event.

26. OTHERS

26.1 Each participating team should provide the Music and Performance plan for Free-style Poomsae to LOC at gm_office@jjinsports.com. (The Performance plan form can be find on GMS registration page)

Performed techniques must be within boundary of taekwondo. The definition of taekwondo techniques shall be determined by WT Poomsae Committee, when contestant submits performance plan of free style Poomsae.
