Every WT Member National Association shall enter as a maximum of 2 male and 2 female in total. weight division at the Oceania Tournament for TOKYO 2020 Paralympic Games.

In accordance with the WT Standing Procedures for the Paralympic Games Article 11.9 will be in effect for the African Para Taekwondo Qualification Tournament for Tokyo

2020 Paralympic Games.

9.6 A MNA, other than the host country, may participate in Continental Qualification tournament as long as:

9.6.1 The athletes' gender and weight categories in the Continental Qualification tournament are not those for which the NPC already obtained a qualification slot through

World Ranking;

9.6.2 The number of athletes qualified through World Ranking of the pertinent NPC does

not exceed the minimum quota of two (2) men and two (2) women places respectively.

## GLOBAL ATHLETE LICENCE & ONLINE REGISTRATION

#### **WT Global License Registration**

All Athletes and Team officials must FIRST be registered with a valid 2020 WT License. You will not be able to register without renewing the license for 2020

#### **WT Online Registration**

National Team Entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system and registration is only possible with a valid WT Global License. National Team GMS administrators will be notified via email once online registration is open.





EVENT REGISTRATION	Registration will only be accepted through the WT Event Registration System ( <a href="https://worldtkd.simplycompete.com">https://worldtkd.simplycompete.com</a> ) and registration is only possible with a valid 2020 WT Global License and WT Event Pass.  Entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system. The WT GMS event registration admin can register the team as soon as all team members have valid WT Global License.	
INDEMNITIES	The respective participants shall be responsible for ensuring that they have validly completed and agreed to the relevant declarations during registration, thus indemnifying the organizers and the WTO, its officials and other contestants from any claims of injuries, losses, fatalities or otherwise arising in the course of participation in this championships or any activities thereto.	





#### **DEADLINES**

The entry fees must be paid online in the GMS at the time of registration. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without verified payment of entry fee to the Organising Committee.

Entry deadline is **31 January 2020, 11:59PM (GMT+10:00 Australia/Sydney).** Entry submission after this date will be not accepted under any circumstances. Late withdrawal due to injury shall be handled case by case.

#### **IMPORTANT:**

The registered athletes or team officials may be removed without any penalty until 11:59 PM, AEST **20 January 2020.** 

## REGISTRATION, DEADLINES AND ENTRY FEES

If the athlete registered on-line does not take part in the competition for any reason, but he/she has not been removed from the list of participants before 11:59PM, AEST 20 January 2020, his/her team will forfeit 100% of the entry fee.

If a team does not show up at the event and has not requested a participation cancellation before 11:59PM AEST **20 January 2020**, it will be requested to settle the payment of all entry fees in full (100%).

#### **ENTRY FEES**

Athlete Registration: US\$ 180 per athlete

Team officials (above the quota): US\$100 per person

Registration will begin on 01 January 2020, 05:00 PM (GMT+10:00 Australia/Sydney)

Registration will end on 31 January 2020, 11:59PM (GMT+10:00 Australia/Sydney).

WTO reserves the right to accept or reject any late entries, but if accepted, an additional fee of \$25.00 USD on top of usual entry fee will apply.

# INTERNATIONAL CLASSIFICATIONS

International Classification of all Kyorugi (K40 Sport Classes) athletes will take place on 28 February 2020. A schedule for International Classification for all teams and athletes will be set up by the WT/OC and communicated to all teams following the close of registration on January 28, 2020. All teams should prepare their travel for their athletes to be available for International Classification on 28 February 2020.

	Medical Diagnostics From through World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) Following IPC Guidelines on data protection concerning athletes and personal classification information. World Taekwondo has in connection with IPC created the World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS). World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) is our new online registration tool for MNAs to register their new athletes and add Medical Diagnostic Forms (MDF) and pictures to be seen by our Classification Evaluation Committee in order to determine if the new athlete is eligible for Para Taekwondo and meets Minimum Impairment Criteria (MIC). All athletes in the WTCS will require a WT License Number (GAL).

	WTCS Account Policy – Each Member Federation must internally designate exactly one (1) primary user responsible for WTCS Account.
WORLD RANKING AND SEEDING	The Kyorugi (K44/K43 Sport Classes) competitions of the 2020 at the Oceania Qualification Tournament for TOKYO 2020 Paralympic Games.  Athletes will be seeded in accordance with the WT World Para Taekwondo Competition Rules.
METHOD OF COMPETITION	Kyorugi The competitions in the K40 Sport Classes at the Oceania Qualification Tournament for TOKYO 2020 Paralympic Games will be held in single elimination tournament system The duration of contest shall be three (3) rounds of two (2) minutes each with a one (1) minute rest period between rounds. In the case of a tied score after the completion of the third (3rd) round, a fourth (4th) round of two (2) minutes will be conducted as the Golden Point round, after a one (1) minute rest period following the third (3rd) round. The duration of contest may be adjusted to one (1) minute x 3 rounds, one (1) minute 30 seconds x three (3) rounds with a 30 second to one (1) minute break between rounds upon the decision of the Technical Delegate for the pertinent Championships.
RESEARCH	WT will conduct research in para taekwondo kyorugi competition performance factors. Injury surveillance research as well as research into athlete classification will also be conducted during the Oceania Qualification Tournament for TOKYO 2020 Paralympic Games. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION	Round trip airfare and accommodation: Round trip airfare and accommodation will need to be organised by Member National Association with costs being be borne by the participating Member National Association.  Ground transportation: ground transportation to and from the airport, as well as transportation from the accommodation to the competition venue shall be borne by the participating Member National Association.



HEAD OF TEAM MEETING & DRAWING OF LOTS	The Head of Team meeting shall be conducted by WTO officials on 28 February 2019. Exact location and time shall be communicated forthwith.		
WEIGH-IN	Weigh-in of the athletes takes place the day prior to the start of the respective weight category they compete in. During the weigh-in, the male athlete shall wear underpants and the female athlete shall wear underpants and brassiere. However, the athlete may weigh in nude if he/she wishes to do so.		
	Each athlete shall have one (1) attempt to pass the weigh in. However, one (1) extra attempt is allowed for those athletes who did not qualify the first time. This extra attempt shall be done within the time limit of the official weigh-in.		
	A Visa to enter Australia may be necessary.  The visa recommendation letters will be automatically generated from WT GMS platform if the visa requested during the registration for the event. All the members who need entry visa to Australia must be registered in GMS. The deadline for a visa request in the GMS platform is 30 January 2020.
