QUALIFICATION SYSTEM	<ul> <li>i. Any NOC who qualifies a minimum of two (2) male and two (2) female players via the Olympic ranking system will be deemed to have qualified its total quota of places and shall not be permitted to enter the continental qualification events. However, if a nation has not qualified a minimum of two (2) places in male and two (2) places in female via the Olympic Ranking position they shall be allowed to compete for the additional places via the continental qualification events.</li> <li>ii. The first ranked athletes in the weight categories will qualify their NOCs a place each for Olympic games. Total eight (8) athletes will qualify their NOCs a place each for Olympic games through Oceania Qualification Tournament.</li> <li>iii. The winner of the final within a weight division will qualify their NOCs. The 3rd place will be determined by the result of final matches.</li> <li>iv. If an NOC qualified through the Oceania Qualification Tournament relinquishes a quota place or has not confirmed the use of the qualified place(s) within two (2) weeks from the moment receiving the allocation letter from the WT, it will be reallocated to the NOC of the next highest ranked athlete in the same weight category at the Oceania Continental Qualification Tournament, as long as the NOC does not exceed the quota of two (2) male and two (2) female.</li> <li>v. In the event that any of the qualified contestants was found to have committed a doping offence that constitutes a violation of any of the provisions of the Anti-Doping Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency and/or other appropriate anti-doping codes ("Anti-Doping Codes"), next highest ranked athlete in the same weight category at the African Continental Qualification Tournament will qualify his/her NOC a place.</li> <li>vi. The NOC of an athlete who has committed an anti-doping rules violation will lose the quota place obtained by the athlete. The maximum number of quota places for that the corresponding number of athletes who committed an offence shall reduce NOC.</li></ul>
AWARDS	Medals will be awarded to the top four athletes in the respective weight category of the pertinent championships:  1st place – gold medal and certificate 2nd place – silver medal and certificate 3rd place – bronze medal and certificate 3rd place – bronze medal and certificate
COACHES ACCREDITATIONS AND QUALIFICATIONS	The minimum qualification requirements for coaches are as follows:  All coaches must be at least 18 years of age.  All Coaches / Trainers must be holders of WTO License (granted by participation in a WTO Coach License Seminar  Coaches / Trainers that do not have the WTO Coach License shall pay a \$ 200.00 USD fine at the registration desk before any coaching accreditation can be issued.



	During the preliminary rounds, coaches shall wear either a neat tracksuit or a shirt, pants and		
	suit jacket.		
DRESS CODE	Please note that for semi-finals and finals it is a WT requirement that coaches wear a suit jacket.		
	During the Head of Team meeting, further information about dress code shall be provided to the teams.		
	DAEDO Gen. 2 is being used as the PSS. The Organising Committee will provide DAEDO trunk protector and DAEDO headgear.		
PROTECTOR & SCORING SYSTEM (PSS)	The PSS and hit-levels to be used at these Oceania Qualification Tournament for the Games of the XXXII Olympiad will be equivalent to those to be used at the TOKYO 2020 Games.		
	IMPORTANT NOTE: Athletes must supply their own DAEDO sensor socks.

IDENTIFIATION OF NOC CODE AND MANUFACTURER	NOC Code is a three-letter National Olympic Committee abbreviation, and it shall be printed at the back in black and centred at 5cm or higher from the bottom line of the upper garment within the size of 30cm width x 12cm height. The font of the letters shall be in bold "Verdana".		
	Manufacturer's identification (name, designation trademark, logo or any distinctive sign of the manufacturer) shall be located one per garment within 20CM except at the location of the WT logo.

	The entry fees must be paid online in the GMS at the time of registration. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without verified payment of entry fee to the Organising Committee.		
	Entry deadline is <b>31 January 2020, 11:59PM (GMT+10:00 Australia/Sydney).</b> Entry submission after this date will be not accepted under any circumstances. Late withdrawal due to injury shall be handled case by case.		
	IMPORTANT:		
	The registered athletes or team officials may be removed without any penalty until 11:59 PM, AEST <b>20 January 2020.</b>		
	If the athlete registered on-line does not take part in the competition for any reason, but he/she has not been removed from the list of participants before 11:59PM, AEST <b>20 January 2020</b> , his/her team will forfeit 100% of the entry fee.

CONDITIONS OF	Round trip airfare and accommodation: Round trip airfare and accommodation will need to be organised by Member National Association with costs being be borne by the participating Member National Association.
PARTICIPATION	Ground transportation: ground transportation to and from the airport, as well as transportation from the accommodation to the competition venue shall be borne by the participating Member National Association.
HEAD OF TEAM MEETING & DRAWING OF LOTS	The Head of Team meeting shall be conducted by WTO officials on 28 February 2019. Exact location and time shall be communicated forthwith.
WEIGH-IN	Weigh-in of the athletes takes place the day prior to the start of the respective weight category they compete in. During the weigh-in, the male athlete shall wear underpants and the female athlete shall wear underpants and brassiere. However, the athlete may weigh in nude if he/she wishes to do so.
	Each athlete shall have one (1) attempt to pass the weigh in. However, one (1) extra attempt is allowed for those athletes who did not qualify the first time. This extra attempt shall be done within the time limit of the official weigh-in.
	A Visa to enter Australia may be necessary.
	The visa recommendation letters will be automatically generated from WT GMS platform if the visa requested during the registration for the event. All the members who need entry visa to Australia must be registered in GMS. The deadline for a visa request in the GMS platform is 30 January 2020.
